T-7A Recapitalization at Vance Air Force Base (AFB). Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) Open House

What: Air Force Public Scoping Meetings

The Department of the Air Force (DAF) proposes to recapitalize the T-38C Talon flight training program at Vance AFB with T-7A Red Hawk aircraft. This proposal supports the Secretary of the Air Force's strategic basing decisions to recapitalize existing T-38C pilot training installations, and Vance AFB would be the fourth installation to be analyzed for possible recapitalization.

When and Where: June 25, or June 26, 2024 from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m.

Public scoping meetings will be held at the Autry Technology Center (1201 W Willow Road, Enid, OK). Meetings will be an open-house style with poster stations and the public is invited to drop in at their convenience anytime during the listed dates and times.
